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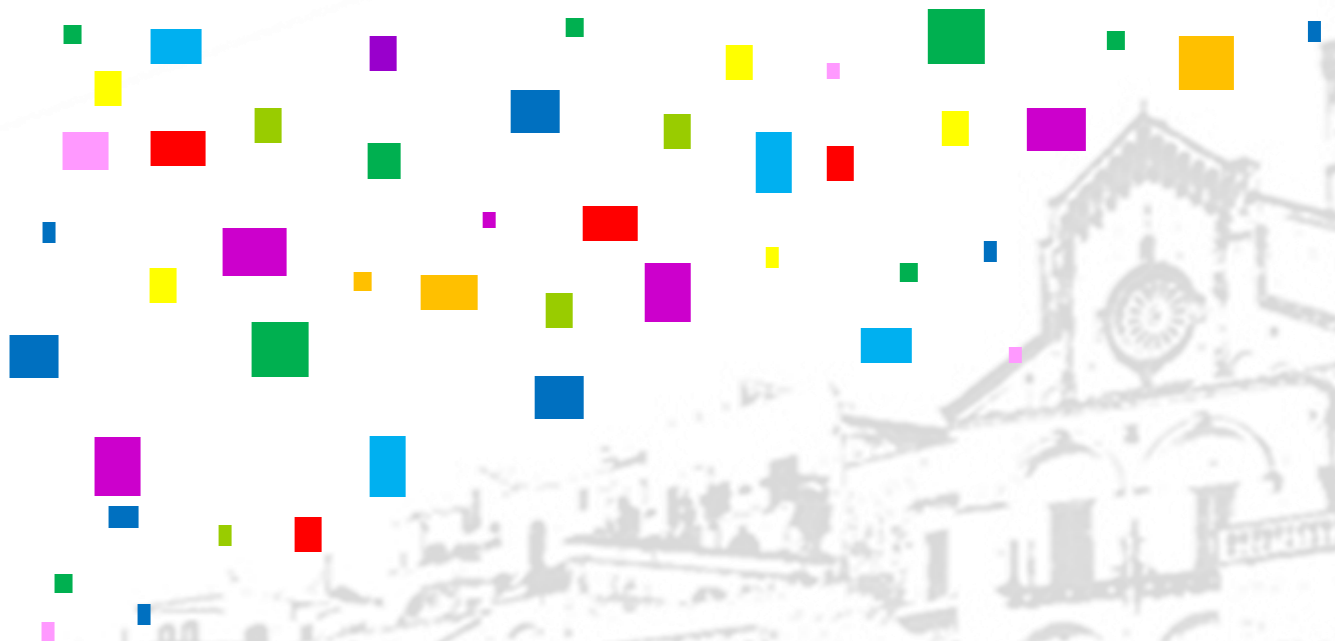

The Project

Matera “European Capital of Culture 2019” promotes an innovative approach to cultural and social development: drawing from the past young people learn to look at the future with a sense of belonging and to protect their common cultural heritage, whilst developing greater understanding of local history, culture and art. The aim of the project “**Cultural itineraries - From Schools to Schools**” is to empower students from the Basilicata Region to take an active role in fostering local cultural heritage. There are **23 itineraries**, all developed by students from schools across the Basilicata Region after entering a call launched by the Ministry of Education, University and Research, in collaboration with the Regional Education Office of Basilicata. **Students took on a leading role** by giving voice to local history, traditions and customs thereby promoting local cultural heritage during 2019 and beyond.



How to Access the Itineraries

The **23 cultural routes** follow the same pattern and are **divided into days**, however each itinerary may be customized according to the needs of visiting schools. In addition, depending on the time of the year, the itineraries may be combined with events included in the **cultural programme of Matera 2019** (www.matera-basilicata2019.it/it/), by acquiring a special “passport” granting temporary citizenship in Matera throughout the year 2019.
