### Scope and objectives of the proposed Action

The purpose of this action is to strengthen the role of the Safer Internet Centre (SIC), improving its capacity to provide a range of diversified and up-to-date services and its interoperability with EU core platforms. The general objective is to achieve greater participation of children, teachers and parents, in the development of a better and more inclusive Internet, linked to children and young people's needs. The project target groups are children and adolescents aged between 6 and 18 years, besides teachers, parents and youth professionals.

The specific objective is to ensure that children and young people involved in the project, use digital technologies in a more responsible and safe way.

The project intends to achieve the following specific outcomes:

1. Improved teachers/educators' digital competencies related to the safe use of digital technologies.
2. Improved children's/young people's digital competences, related to the safe use of digital technologies.
3. Reinforced parents' awareness of their role and responsibilities.
4. Reinforced stakeholders' capacity to promote joint and coherent actions related to a safer use of digital technologies.
5. Strengthened the fight against online child sexual exploitation and abuse
6. Reinforced the capacity of the Helpline to provide advice and support to parents and children on online-related issues.
7. Strengthened the cooperation at European level.

A wide range of activities will be part of four main areas identified to ensure the above-mentioned outcomes, including:

- a) Educational and awareness-raising activities targeting young people, teachers, parents and youth professionals;
- b) Up-to-date services - Hotlines and a Helpline-, to support target groups in dealing with harmful content/conduct online and to contrast the spreading of illegal content online, especially online child sexual abuse material;
- c) Activities aimed at strengthening the cooperation between the Safer Internet Centre and relevant actors from private, public and civil society sectors.
- d) Activists to strengthen the relationship between Italian Safer Internet Centre and European key stakeholders in order to influence the ongoing online safety EU agenda.
